Managed Realignment & Tidal Wetland Restoration

A parcel of land between Onslow Road and Salmon River is being restored to a tidal wetland to reduce local flood risk and recover important wildlife habitat.

Restoration will begin in 2021 with the breaching of the old dyke

What to Expect

Tidal wetland habitat recovery is a multi-year process. Before wetland vegetation is established, existing plants will die and land will become muddy.
